2015-20 Charger On-Dash Mount Installation Instructions P/N ODM-CGR



Caution:

Always be sure to secure and lock mount in place before driving.

Always!

- Read all instructions before installing any Lund products.
- Check for obstructions (Wires, brake lines, fuel tank, etc.) before drilling any holes!
 - Use hardware provided with install kit



Dodge Charger Dash
Prior to installation.



Gently pry along the dash with a flat blade panel
removal tool. Slowly working along the frame.



Dash panel partially removed.



Temporarily remove radio touch screen.

NOTE: The touchscreen has a theft deterrent system built
in so we suggest leaving the main power plugged in.



Temporarily remove two (2) OEM screws and
attach support bracket with OEM screw as shown.
10mm socket.



Repeat process for both sides.
Make sure brackets fit around radio snug.



Reinstall the radio touch screen using the previously removed OEM hardware. Add the top support bracket to the upper right side of radio.



Attach side mounting brackets to the side support brackets using provided flange nuts.



Repeat process for driver side and tighten hardware.



Carefully reinstall previously removed dash panel.



Make sure the side mounting brackets are even along the dash and the dash is fully seated back into place.



Attach the passenger side frame bracket using the supplied (2) 10-32 screws.



Now attach the drivers side frame bracket using the supplied (2) 10-32 screws as shown.



You should now have all 3 brackets mounted and ready to attach the main frame.



Place the main frame in position. Screw in the 2 provided 10-32 screws on the passenger side. Do not fully tighten until the end.



Next same process for the drivers side except only one screw. Once again do not fully tighten yet.



Lastly attach the top support bracket to the frame. You can now fully tighten all the screws.



Finally you can install your dock, tablet or monitor mount.
